Michael Tanner heads research into a variety of domestic policies with a particular emphasis on health care reform, social welfare policy, and Social Security. Author of numerous books and studies, Mr. Tanner will discuss his most recent study titled The Work Versus

Welfare Tradeoff: 2013, which estimates the value of the full package of welfare benefits available to a typical recipient in each of the 50 states and the District of Columbia. Tanner's study concluded that Massachusetts is the third-most generous in the nation in providing welfare funds. Tanner's writings have appeared in nearly every major American newspaper, including the New York Times, Washington Post, Los Angeles Times, Wall Street Journal, and USA Today. He writes a weekly column for National Review Online, and is a contributing columnist with the New York Post. A prolific writer and frequent guest lecturer, Tanner appears regularly on network and cable news programs.
